





"Chastity is the most unpopular of the Christian virtues. Of course, being a Christian, I think it is the instinct which has gone wrong. You can get a large audience together for a striptease act—that is, to watch a girl undress on the stage.



1 Corinthians 6:13-15 NIV




Truth About SEX




Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body.
